We have also posted an update to SDUH to support Win7/64-bit machines.

AES 2011 will be downloadable from the AES website; a CD mailer is available on request for a shipping and handling fee of \$19.95. All AES software is scanned with Kaspersky Anti-Virus software and the latest signatures files prior to publication.
